Korie also is the first white American to be appointed as an Indian Police Officer in Arizona, California and Nevada (Monjave Tribes).

Korie initiated Night Court for the Justice Court System in Las Vegas to prevent a backlog of small claim and traffic cases, so that the citizens will not lose time on their jobs.

Korie is a member of the National Judges Association of Non - Attorney Judicial Officers in good standing.
