In the past three months there have been Burglaries and Attempt Burglaries at 6428 Burgundy Way. The total number of Burglaries and Attempts this date have been 24.

CON GAME - \$1,000 CASH REWARD:
On Wednesday, 10:30 A.M., August 18, 1982, an elderly woman became the victim of a con game in the 1900 block of Ballard Street. The victim was contacted by phone by a person who stated he was a Lt. Parker of the Metro Police Department and convinced the victim that her residence was going to be burglarized by a person who was in custody. The suspect further advised the victim that an officer would come to her residence to protect her property. The second person arrived at her residence and convinced the victim to give him her jewelry to be used as evidence. Taken was: One (1) ladies ring, white gold, set with one karat diamond with numerous small diamonds; one (1) ladies ring, 60 point diamonds set in a square; \$60,000 in cash receipts from her business.
