

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Menahem Savidor, Speaker of the Knesset, was the guest of honor at a meeting here of the Advisory Board of the Friends of the Jerusalem College of Technology on September 13. Founded in 1970, the College has made a major contribution to Israel's defense requirement through its research facilities, faculty and students.

BRUSSELS (WNS) -- Belgian authorities have started an investigation to learn the identity of the publisher of a reprint of Hitler's Mein Kampf, to determine whether the republication is a violation of Belgian law. Dries van Agt, the Dutch Foreign Minister said in The Hague that he has asked the Dutch Embassy in Brussels to check reports that the Hitler opus had been reprinted in Belgium and was on sale in supermarkets in Flanders in Belgium. A reprint was confiscated in the Netherlands in 1974 on grounds that material advocating racism and xenophobia was illegal. Anti-Semitic and racist materials are violations of Belgian law.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The resignation of Rep. Frederick Richmond (D, NY) bring the number of Jews in the House of Representatives down to 25. Richmond resigned after pleading guilty to evading nearly \$50,000 in income tax payments, possessing marijuana and illegally paying \$7,420 to a Navy employee who helped obtain a business for the Brooklyn Navy Yard. Richmond was first elected to Congress in 1974 and served a Brooklyn district that while largely Black, also included the Brooklyn Heights area and part of the heavily hasidic Williamsburg area.

WASHINGTON (WMS) -- Tadiran, Israel Electronic Industry, was awarded a \$39 million contract by the U.S. army to build radios for the M-1 Battle Tank and other military vehicles, it was announced here by the Pentagon. Tadiran, which is 44 percent owned by GTE International, said it plans to build the radios in Holon.

BUENOS AIRES (WNS) -- The English language daily, the Buenos Aires Herald, reported here that Argentina is negotiating the purchase of 22 Mirage jets from Israel in order to rebuild its Air Force after losing the war with Britain over the Falkland Islands last June. After great losses of planes in the war, Argentina procured 10 Mirages from Peru which it incorporated into its air offensive along with the Israel Kfir and the French Super Entendard jets, outfitted with Exocet missiles.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- A delegation of five Lebanese intellectuals met with Foreign Minister Yitzhak Shamir. The delegation, the first such group to visit Israel, included Thomas Mouhanna, dean of the faculty of philosophy at the University of Beirut, and Robert Ghanen, president of the Supreme Court. Some members of the delegation told the Foreign Minister that they supported a peace agreement between Lebanon and Israel. But others said it was entirely up to the new government of President-elect Bashir Gemayel to decide this issue.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Former Vice President Walter Mondale told the closing session of the North American Leadership Conference of the Israel Bond Organization that "No President should intimidate, threaten or undermine the security of Israel." He added that "the present Administration makes a mistake not to emphasize the CampDavid agreement." Mondale also urged the appointment of a high level senior official in the Reagan Administration to continue the peace process.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The Senate Foreign Relations Committee adopted a resolution expressing the sense of the committee that Israel's Red Cross the Magen David Adom, should be formally recognized by the International League of Red Cross societies.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Prime Minister Menachem Begin of Israel has called on Jewish congregants in North American synagogues for a "unique demonstration of Jewish unity" with Israel through this year's Israel Bond High Holy Day Appeals. In letters to the presidents of the three major rabbinical organizations, the Prime Minister expressed his appreciation for "the vital role which Israel Bonds has undertaken to help offset the impact on our economy resulting from Operation Peace for Galilee." Israel Bond holiday appeals in some 1,100 congregations in the U.S. and Canada will culminate the special Emergency Development for Peace campaign undertaken by the Bond Organization shortly after the onset of the Lebanon events to help Israel maintain the pace and tempo of its economy.

BALTIMORE (WNS) -- Baltimore Hebrew College has announced the publication of the book, "In the Service of My People," by Boris Smolar, Editor-in-Chief Emeritus of the Jewish Telegraphic Agency and former roving correspondent in European countries for Pulitzer's New York World.
