vitaly important for the Jewish community to reward our friends in Washington with meaningful political support at the polls, and to withhold support from those who voted against our interests."

Jacobs urged Jews to study the voting records of their Congressmen and Senators, and to take an active part in the political process. He noted that, in the 1980 primary elections, only 30% of American Jews exercised their right to vote, and that, "we must speak to our elected repre-

sentatives through the ballot box if we expect them to heed our voices."

instances of breaking the peace were registered in the three days of demonstrations and riots. Most of Israel's 680,000 Arabs staged a general strike to protest the massacre in Beirut. The strike, called by Arab mayors, was one of the worst the country has known since its establishment.

Unlike previous eruptions of political violence, this time the demonstrations spread like wild fire from northern villages all the way down to the politically low key Bedouin areas in the Negev. The worst demonstrations were in Nazareth. At least 130 persons were wounded, some of them by Police fire, in the various demonstrations. A total of 27 civilian vehicles were wrecked by rioters, and 91 rioters were arrested. Many Jewish settlements which depend on Arab labor were affected by the general strike. Plants and businesses were forced to slow down their operations or halt them altogether because workers failed to show up.

CHALLENGE MEETING OF POPE AND ARAFAT

The president of the international Young Israel movement, Harold M. Jacobs, has expressed shock and concern that, "the Pope, the religious leader of hundreds of millions of Catholics throughout the world and a leader in the struggle against totalitarianism could lend credibility to Yasser Arafat, who is the leader of the Communist-inspired international terrorist network."

Jacobs noted that, "Arafat, as the leader of the PLO, is directly responsible for the deaths of tens of thousands of Lebanese Christians during its civil war over

the past decade.

"He also has directed the indiscriminate mass murder of civilians, including women and children, in terrorist acts throughout the Middle East and the world.

"We do not understand how the Pope, who personally has fought against the totalitarian ideology which Arafat represents, and who is one of the world's most respected religious leaders, could meet with such an individual. Lending support to Arafat in such a way is totally inconsistent with the most basic concepts of religious morality."

ARAB VILLAGES CALM

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Arab villages throughout Israel returned to normal after three days of mass demonstrations and riots. Municipal and village employees were clearing up and repairing roads and removing roadblocks and burned tires. Shops and schools reopened, and cafes were filled with Arab men playing their traditional and seemingly endless backgammon games.

SOVIET JEWISH ACTIVIST ARRESTED

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Feliks Kuchubievsky, of Novosibirsk, a veteran emigration activist, was arrested and charged with "circulation of fabrications known to be false which defame the Soviet state and social system," it was reported here. Under Soviet law, he faces a maximum penalty of three years imprisonment or "internal exile."

The 52-year-old engineer, a recipient of the Soviet Order of Merit for Patriotic Work, and his wife,

Valentina, have been the constant target of KGB harassment since they applied for emigration to Israel in May 1978. Kuchubievsky has been accused of "counter-revolutionary activities" for his writings which Soviet authorities claim contain material which slanders the Soviet Union. He was first warned about these writings last March and told that if he continued it could provoke a harsh reaction in the future.

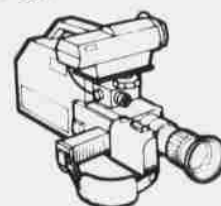
