

## WESTERN EUROPE SHOCKED AT BEIRUT MASSACRE

PARIS (WNS) -- Western Europe reacted with shock and horror to the massacre of Palestinians at the refugee camps in Beirut. The European Economic Community (EEC) called for the immediate withdrawal of all Israeli forces from Beirut and an eventual withdrawal in the "near future" from all of Lebanon as well.

British Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher was quoted as having said in Tokyo, where she is on an official visit, that the killings of the Palestinian people in the refugee camps "are unbelievable barbarism." In Paris, President Francois Mitterrand issued a statement expressing his "horror" and calling for speedy international action to pre-

vent a recurrence. The Italian government rapped the massacre and also indirectly charged Israel with responsibility on the killings. The Spanish government also violently condemned the killings and mentioned Israeli responsibility while Greek Premier Andreas Papandreou termed the massacre "an anti-Palestinian genocide."

In Moscow, the Soviet government for the first time ever called for Israel's expulsion from the United Nations. Tass, the official news Agency, carried a dispatch saying the Soviet government will propose that the matter be taken up by an extraordinary session of the General Assembly.

The Tass dispatch said "there is no

place for countries like Israel, which totally disregard international law and commitments, within the United Nations."

The Egyptian government of President Hosni Mubarak announced that Ambassador Saad Mortada has been summoned home from Israel for consultations. Mortada delivered the news personally to Foreign Minister Yitzhak Shamir and later met at his own request with President Yitzhak Navon. Both Israeli leaders expressed the hope that he would be back soon, and he, according to Israeli sources, joined in that hope.

tails were known to Goodman and other Israeli reporters prior to the published account but that it could not be reported at that time.

Other Israeli newspapers and the State radio correspondent, Shmuel Tal, said that the Times' report was "overdramatized and exaggerated." But it was generally acknowledged that some officers demanded that Sharon resign. The meeting, held at an undisclosed location outside Tel Aviv, lasted six hours. It was described as "highly emotional but nowhere near a mutiny." Officers who had criticized Sharon sharply earlier were said to have modified their tone in his presence. According to reports, Sharon attacked the officers for demanding the resignation of a minister and advised them to resign their own commissions if they wanted to enter politics.

## SIX ISRAELI SOLDIERS KILLED IN AMBUSH

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Six Israeli soldiers were killed and 22 wounded earlier in the month in an ambush just north of the Beirut - Damascus highway in Lebanon. Army sources said the ambush appeared to have been carefully planned. It was the second of two buses transporting Israeli soldiers east from the Beirut area which came under attack from bazooka rocket and small arms fire from surrounding hills.

According to the army, the attackers apparently were familiar with Israeli movements and were probably aided by local townspeople and received support from PLO bases beyond Syrian lines. The army said that of the 22 wounded soldiers, 11 were seriously hurt and the rest were only slightly wounded. Israel radio quoted official sources here as saying that the ambush "proved" how vital it was to get the PLO out of Lebanon. The sources did not blame Syria directly for the attack although it oc-

Syrian and PLO forces. The Israeli Cabinet met briefly Oct. 4, apparently to discuss the ambush. The ministers sat as a ministerial defense committee, the deliberations of which are classified and no statements were issued.

Meanwhile Israeli aircraft destroyed

a Syrian SAM - 9 anti-aircraft missile launcher in Lebanon Oct. 4. A military spokesman said the attack was at Deit el-

Beida, east of Beirut and just north of the Beirut - Damascus highway. But government sources insisted it was not in retaliation for the ambush the day before in the same vicinity.

In Washington, the State Department deplored both the ambush on the bus and Israel's apparent retaliation.
