

SOMEBODY CARES AT NLV CARE UNIT

They may drink. Then again, they may not. They are young, old, or maybe middle-aged and married for years. They are husband, wife, friend, boss, co-worker and even a small child. They are the true victims of alcoholism - the co-alcoholics. People who watch while someone they love drinks himself or herself to death.

Alcoholism kills. It kills directly, through the liver, the heart, the pancreas. And it kills indirectly, through drunk driving, suicide, and the brutal violence that often follows heavy drinking.

Alcoholism can also kill love.

Catherine is 38 years old. She has wearily watched her husband lose 10 jobs since their marriage 16 years ago. She has lived with the heart-

ache, the blackouts, and the broken promises. She has believed him each time he said he would quit. She has continually covered up or lied to keep him from getting fired. But now she's scared, frightened, for herself and for her children.

John has hit her three times, her five-year-old son twice. Each time he apologizes and promises never to do it again. But Catherine has heard these promises before -- about his drinking -- and things only got worse. Now the two-year-old's crying is getting on his nerves and she's afraid to leave the baby alone with him.

Catherine is not alone. A recent Gallup Poll found that 22 percent of American families are dramatically touched by alcoholism and problem drinking.

"Alcoholism is a family disease," says Mark Augenstein, Program Coordinator at North Las Vegas CareUnit, a facility that specializes in treating adult alcoholics and their families.

"Few treatment programs do the extensive family therapy we do," continues Augenstein. "We realize how difficult it is for the family of an alcoholic to forgive and forget. And after the alcoholic completes treatment, he or she needs to return to a loving, supportive environment. Through therapy we are able to help rebuild a supportive family environment."

TRIBUTE TO ARTHUR RUBINSTEIN



NEW YORK -- The gala October 18th Weizmann Institute dinner at the Waldorf-Astoria, which features a tribute to Maestro Arthur Rubinstein for his support of scientific research at Weizmann and artistic creativity in Israel's cultural life, is expected to draw a capacity attendance of one thousand guests.

The dinner will provide the opportunity for a reunion between Maestro Rubinstein and Conductor Zubin Mehta, both of whom will fly in specially for the occasion. The two musical luminaries last made music together in 1976, when they recorded a Brahms concerto with the Israel Philharmonic in the pianist's final year of public performances. Most recently, Maestro Rubinstein has been living in retire-

Frederic Mann, a long-time friend of Maestro Rubinstein, chairs the Tribute Committee of musical celebrities whose members will pay homage to the 95-year-old pianist and author at the Weizmann dinner. 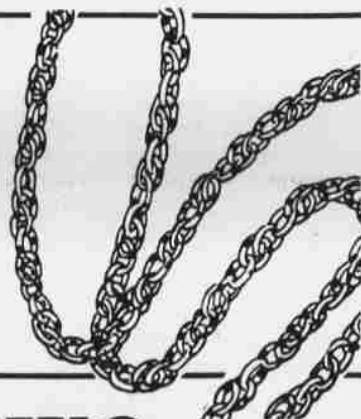
