

PERES OUTLINES

LABOR PARTY POSITION

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- In a wide ranging address before a 40 - person group of executives of Israel Bond Organization, Labor Party opposition leader Shimon Peres spoke out in favor of Israeli settlements remaining on the West Bank under Jordanian sovereignty in a peace settlement. Peres, speaking to the group, said the West Bank Jewish settlements could remain part and parcel of Jordan in the peace plan favored by the Labor Alignment, apparently part of the peace plan enunciated by President Reagan which called for a confederation between the West Bank and Jordan.

As there are Arab settlements under non - Arab administration, so there could be Jewish settlements under non - Jewish sovereignty, he noted, stressing that the Jewish people have the right to reside and settle in the West Bank. He explained that it would be extremely unreasonable to think that a Jewish government will agree that every-

body has a right to live in the West Bank but the Jewish people. Peres, during his speech, set out his party's conditions for a settlement of the Palestinian problem -- the establishment of a Jordanian-Palestinian framework to include all the Palestinians residing in Jordan, the West Bank and Gaza.

The opposition leader pointed out that the two basic conditions were that the Israel armed forces will remain along side of the Jordan River and the territory which is returned to Jordan is to be demilitarized, without a hostile army. Peres described this plan as having been more or less accepted by Reagan and also accepted in principle by Jordanian leader, King Hussein, and the Egyptians, and many leaders on the West Bank.

On the subject of Jerusalem and proposals about East Jerusalem Arabs being entitled to vote for the proposed West Bank autonomy, Peres said he would not exclude the right of Arabs to make such a demand. All ne-

gotiations must be without pre-condition. He recalled a proposal by former U.S. envoy Sol Linowitz that Jerusalem's Arabs might be enabled to vote in abstentia -- casting their ballots in Bethlehem -- and that there were other alternatives. "But for us, Jerusalem is the only capital Israel has...not just the center of the State of Israel but the heart of the Jewish people," Peres declared.

TRIFA ORDERED DEPORTED

WASH. (WNS) -- A federal judge in Detroit has ordered the deportation of Archbishop Valerian Trifa, head of the Rumanian Orthodox Episcopate in America. He has 60 days to find a country that will accept him.

Judge Belino Danbrovic of the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) issued the order after Trifa acknowledged that he was a leader of the Rumanian fascist Iron Guard during World War II and had lied about that connection when he applied for ad-

mission to the U.S. in July 1950.

The Iron Guard was responsible for the January 1941 pogrom in Bucharest. Trifa's admission brought to an abrupt halt deportation hearing which began in Detroit October 4 and were expected to last 4 - 5 weeks.

No details of the arrested suspects have been released. The Baptist Church, a wooden structure situated in downtown Jerusalem, is run by Minister Robert Lindsay, an old friend of Israel who has lived here since 1939.
