She was later identified as MICHELLE LAMATIA, formerly of St. Louis. Homicide Detectives said the woman was believed to have been a prostitute and had been dead for less than 24 hours, due to strangulation.

**MURDER - \$1,000 CASH REWARD:**

On Friday, September 10, 1982, at approximately 8:45 P.M., RICHARD NEAL DIAMOND, (White Male, 25 years, 5-6, brown hair, hazel eyes) was shot to death with a large caliber weapon while he was standing in front of the Miracle Mile Trailer Park, 3642 Boulder Highway. The suspects fled the scene in a large sedan, dark brown or copper in color.

**MURDER - \$1,000 CASH REWARD:**

On Sunday, October 10, 1982, at approximately 2:20 P.M., a person hiking in a wash off the North Shore Road at the Lake Mead National Recreation area found the remains of a body being a white male. The wash itself is 10.7 miles from the intersection of Lake Mead Drive and the North Shore Road. The torso of the body was gone, presumed to have been eaten by animals that are in that area. Also, the pelvis of the body and the bottoms of the feet were gone. The victim's hands were tied in the rear of the head. The pants worn by the victim were dark blue, flared at the bottom, no rear pockets. A white long-sleeved shirt, brand name "Charlie," was also on the victim. The victim had been shot twice in the head. At present, the victim of this murder has not been identified.
