Friend WALTER KANE, before returning to the proddings of medics at Sunrise Hospital, handed over the DAVID McCLINTICK book, "Indecent Exposure" that had Hollywood chattering for months. It's about the board room battle be-tween Columbia pix prez ALAN HIRSCHFIELD and HERBERT ALLEN JR., principally, ALLEN being a scion of the New York Investment banking firm of Allen & Co., which had bought control of Columbia Pictures in 1973 and recruited his friend ALAN to run it. And what friends they turned out to be! The tension and thrust of the plot sprang from the embezzlement and forgery Columbia's hotshot studio head DAVID BEGELMAN, on the eve of his greatest hit, "Close Encounters of the Third Kind." Its a thriller, bringing back memories of those years 1977-78 when Variety editor TOM PRYOR called me to start some undercover investigation about BEGELMAN's possible gambling losses here after rumors abounded in Hollywood about his \$400,000 and \$500,000 drops at baccarat.

Couldn't find out a thing and it wasn't a coverup by casino heads here -- there was no record of any BEGELMAN heavy losses in Vegas...Earlier BEGELMAN was remembered around town as JUDY GARLAND's agent in 1963 and through her husband, SID LUFT, a story appeared in New West about how he took GARLAND for a bath in more ways than one... A phone call about 10 days ago from RUDY VALLEE plaintively wanted to know what was going on at Imperial Palace. He had brought up his one-man show material, all of it on tape with slides etc., but they evidently fluffed him off. In a follow-up letter he wrote that he and Mrs. V are coming up Dec. 5 with some Houston friends for a Desert Inn soljourn. He makes mention of playing the Last Frontier in 1947 booked by his buddy WALTER KANE "for two weks for four thousand which was something in those days!!!" didn't know WALTER was booking the Last Frontier during those years. In my look through the rearview mirror, it was MAXINE LEWIS who was entertainment booker and director followed by DOUG FARNOW after she was lured up to the Flamingo after BUGSY SIEGEL. was killed in 1948 Anyway, this long ramble is a cheerio to WALTER KANE, now out of the hospital and again on the mend.
