of Newton, Mass, be named as full participating members of the team, which will go to Taiwan later this month to take part in the sixth World Karate Championship.

Sukenik and Glaser are both black belts in Shotokan Karate and are ranked among the top four female amateur Karate athletes in the U.S.

Both are observant Jews who refused to participate in a squad selection tournament Sept. 18 and 19, during the Jewish holiday.

When the National Amateur Athletic Union Karate Committee, Inc., which is responsible for selecting the squad refused to give them a "make up" chance, the American Jewish Congress asked lawyers in New York and Boston to file suit, charging religious discrimination.

An AJCongress official, Nathan Z. Dershowitz, head of the organization's commission on law and social action, likened the case to that of the clergyman in the film "Chariots of Fire," who refused to run on Sunday. "Miss Sukenik and Miss Glaser were only following their conscience," he said. "They should not be penalized for it."
