MOSHE ARENS AGREES TO SERVE AS ISRAEL'S DEFENSE MINISTER

SOVIET MISSLES IN SYRIA

According to American and Israeli reports, the Soviet Union is now constructing two SA-5, surface - to - air missile complexes in Syria. The SA-5 is a long - range stradefense tegic air weapon never before deployed outside the Soviet Union.

According to press reports, the SA-5 complexes are located at Dumayr, an air base about 40 kilometers (25 miles) northeast of Damascus, and at Homs, a city near Lebanon's northern border with Syria. SA-5 missiles fired from these com-

plexes can reach all of Lebanon, northern and central Israel, and parts of Cyprus and Turkey.

The transfer of SA-5 anti - aircraft missiles to Syria has diplomaimportant strategic tic and implications. It inrenewed dicates a and strengthened Soviet commitment to Syria. The willingness of the Soviets to transfer a weapon previously used only for air defense of their homeland against American strategic air attacks, and their evident decision to man the weapons using (Continued on Page 3)

SHARON RETAINED AS MINISTER-WITHOUT-PORTFOLIO

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Knesset approved by a vote of 61 - 56 the Cabinet decision to retain Ariel Sharon as a Minister-Without-Portfolio after he was forced to resign as Defense Minister because of the findings and recommendations of the Commission of Inquiry into the massacre of Palestinians by Christian Phalangist forces in the Sabra and Shatila refugee camps in Beirut last September. Sharon's resignation took effect on February 14. Begin will assume the responsibilities of Defense Minister temporarily until his choice to replace Sharon, Moshe Arens, Israel's Ambassador to the United States, returns from Washington and is formally installed.

Begin's personal aide, Yehiel Kadishai, announced that Arens had agreed to serve. Approval of his nomination by the Knesset is virtually certain. Leaders of Likud's Liberal Party wing reportedly told Begin they would back Arens' appointment without reservation. The opposition

Letter to the Editor & Retraction

(EDITOR'S NOTE: The cartoon that recently appeared in the Review-Journal aroused the ire of the Jewish community. Here at the ISRAELITE we were overwhelmed with outcry and we feel that this letter written by Rabbi Mel Hecht of Congregation Ner Tamid reflects the sentiment of the Jewish community expressed to us.

Also, we reprinted the R-J's retraction which appeared in their publication, Sun., Feb. 20th.)

Dear Michael:

As a Rabbi, I am grateful for your paper reprinting my response. However, this kind of problem will not be solved by allowing any member of the Jewish community or any other minority group to respond after the damage has been done.

Responsible institutions serving the public have standard operating procedures reflecting a philosophy that preclude any representative of that institution overstepping their bounds.

I'm disappointed and angered over the inclusion of a cartoon in the Review-Journal on Sunday, February 13th. It equated former Israeli Defense Minister, Ariel Sharon, with Klaus Barbie, the nazi who was returned to France for prosecution of crimes against humanity. The cartoon depicted two butcher shops, one titled "Butcher of Lyon, Klaus Barbie, manager;" the other, "Butcher of Beirut, Ariel Sharon, manager."

How dare they allow the comparison of a nazi who deliberately and premeditatively killed, maimed and tortured his fellowman to a man who at the most exercised poor judgement in allowing Lebanese Christians to enter Palestinian camps to dislodge PLO terrorists. How easy it became to use Sharon as the scapegoat for the acts of others. How easy it is to divert attention away from the real perpetrators of that horrendous act. What Arab country has ever sought - as Israel has - to publicly examine its own motives and actions
