Starring in this musical tribute to the legacy of Duke Ellington are Paula Kelly, Harold Nicholas and Freda Payne, No strangers to the music of the Duke, each brings a special brand of magic to the show. Dancer Paula Kelly

completed recently a successful ninemonth run in the Los Angeles company of "Sophisticated La-dies." She also ap-Lapeared as a special guest star in the national live cable telecast of the musical. She has many Broadway and national stage credits, the most notable her leading per-formance in the Los Angeles production of "Don't Bother Me, I Can't Cope."

Harold Nicholas, who also appeared in the Los Angeles production of "Sophistica-ted Ladies," is part of the famous Nicholas Brothers dance team. He has performed in vaudeville, films, television, theatre, and nightclubs, including the legendary Cotton Club where he appeared with Duke Ellington.
