

Arson Fire - Lake Mead National Recreation Area - Willow Beach Resort.

About 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, February 6, 1983, there was a small brush fire in a grassy area near the Willow Beach Restaurant, Later that same night, a house trailer within the resort area was totally destroyed by fire. That same night the contents of two trash dumpsters caught fire.
