JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- B'nai B'rith International and B'nai B'rith District 21 (Australia) have opened a campaign for the relief of victims of the bushfires that recently swept across the southern coast of Australia. Announcing the campaign, Daniel Thursz, B'nai B'rith executive vice president, said that \$1000 had been contributed from the organization's contingency fund and more than \$2,500 from members of the Melbourne, Sydney and Canberra chapters within the first two days of the drive in Australia.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The Herut Zionists of America reported the formation of Tagar, a new zionist student activist movement affiliated with the Herut Zionists of America and the Betar Zionist youth movement. The name of the organization was coined by Zeev Jabotinsky, founder of the Revisionist Zionist movement which Herut spokesman said connotes an idealistic attitude "to kindle the flame of a great Jewish national revival" and to "brave the obstacles to Jewish national goals." The founding conference for Tagar was held at the State University of New York at Albany February 20 - 21, and was attended by some 200 students from throughout the United States.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- El Al Airlines has resumed its full schedule of flights between the U.S. and Israel, according to David Schneider, El Al's general manager for North and Central America. El Al will offer daily flights between New York and Tel Aviv except on the Sabbath and Jewish holidays. From June 19 through the summer, the schedule will be increased to two or three flights daily from New York to Israel.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Zubin Mehta, the world-renowned conductor and Music Director of the New York Philharmonic Orchestra, was presented with the Jewish National Fund's TARBUT (Culture) award at a ceremony at Avery Fisher Hall in New York City during the intermission of a recent New York Philharmonic concert. Mr. Mehta was given the award, a three-thousand-year - old archeological artifact from Israel, for his support and encouragement to many young Israeli artists and for his guidance of the Israel Philharmonic Orchestra.

LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- A Jewish extremist group is suspected by police to have placed a bomb at the entrance to the Temple Mount as hundreds of Moslem worshippers were on their way to pray at the mosques there. The bomb was discovered and dismantled safely. A week earlier, a bomb exploded outside a Hebron mosque where worshippers were finishing their morning prayers. No one was hurt but police said the bomb would have caused casualties had it detonated a few minutes later when people were leaving the mosque.

LONDON (WNS). -- Three members of a Baghdad based Palestinian terrorist group were sentenced to 30 and 35 year prison terms in Central Criminal Court here for the attempted assassination of the Israeli Ambassador to Britain, Shlomo Argov, last June 3. The prosecutor said the three were members of the Palestine National Liberation Movement, a breakaway faction of the PLO, headed by Sabri Banna who is known as Abu Nidal. They arrived in Britain in 1980 and attended language courses while preparing "for acts of assassination and sabotage" aimed at Israeli targets, the prosecutors charged. Sentenced were: Hassein Said, 23, a Jordanian national; Marwan Banna, 20, also of Jordan; and Nauoff Rosan, 36, an Iraqi citi-
