The Reagan Administration announced here that the United States has started "high level" talks with Israel to prevent a continuation of clashes between Israeli forces and U.S. marines in the Beirut area.

But the Israel Embassy here said the incidents would not there was occur if a "direct liaison" between the Israel Defense Forces and the U.S. marines as there was between the IDF and other contingents of the force multinational (MNF) in Beirut, consisting of French, British and Italian units.

The Administration and the Embassy were referring to charges by Gen. Robert Barrow, Commandant of the Marine Corps, that Israeli troops are deliberately threatening the lives of American military personnel in Lebanon for 'political purposes."

The charges were contained in a classified letter from Barrow to Defense Secretary Caspar Weinber-ger in which Barrow urged that "firm and




