

### ANTI-JEWISH VIOLENCE AT UN

The World Jewish Congress has formally raised before the UN Human Rights Commission the worldwide anti-Semitic terror attacks of recent month.

The WJC delegate at the Commission, Mr. Robin Gilbert of Geneva, spoke on the increasing manifestation of religious bigotry and discrimination around the world. Dismissing claims that anti-Jewish terror attacks were political in nature, he asked: "What more deliberate anti-Jewish and anti-religious action can there be than bomb-

ing Jews engaged in worship in their synagogue?"

Recalling that this year marked the fiftieth anniversary of Hitler's accession to power, the WJC representative expressed a "profound sense of shock" that even the current Commission has included references "which place Zionism alongside racism and fascism." He declared: "We can only denounce with the utmost contempt the apparent attempt to tarnish the victims with the very crimes and ideologies of the

perpetrators."

Noting the climate of religious and racial intolerance which has led to violence and terrorism of the gravest nature, the WJC statement stressed the need to tackle the root causes of this trend by the educational process and the inculcation of democratic values in young people. "The particular responsibility of governments was stressed as was the necessity of updating legislation "prohibiting incitement to religious, racial and national hatred and violence which flows from intolerance."

The WJC welcomed the Commission's

continued attention to these matters, stressing that "Judaism, which in its sacred teachings proclaims the unity of mankind and its common origin, totally rejects any concept of racism or racial theory."

The World Jewish Congress, representing the Jewish communities of sixty-seven nations, holds consultative status with the UN Economic and Social Council and is formally accredited to participate in the work of the Human Rights Commission.
