EWISH NEWS BRIEFS

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- An Israeli soldier was killed, three others were wounded and three soldiers were treated for shock in five incidents in Lebanon. The dead soldiers was killed as a result of a road accidentarising out of a terrorist attack. He was not immediately identified. The army spokesman said that two soldiers were wounded when an explosive charge was detonated at the side of the road along which their convoy was passing south of Beirut. Another vehicle in the convoy tried to find a point from which to counter attack an ambush but overturned, killing one of its occupants and injuring another.

ROME (WNS) -- Pope John Paul II paid tribute April 13 to the memory of the Jews who died in the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising 40 years ago. They were "our brothers and sisters who suffered with us the tests of the terrible Nazi occupation and received a cruel death," the Pontiff told some 40,000 people in St. Peter's Square gathered for his weekly general audience. He said the uprising "was a desperate cry for the right to live, to be free and for the salvation of human dignity."

- GENEVA (WNS) -- The International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) has declined to confirm or deny that its representative who investigated a mystery ailment on the West Bank shares the Israeli view that the symptoms which sent hundreds of teenage Arab girls to hospitals were a manifestation of mass hysteria. Dr. Franz Altherr, who conducted the investigation on behalf of the Red Cross, has refused to make any comment to the press.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- A public opinion poll published in Maariv shows a steady increase in the percentage of Israelis who oppose any territorial concessions on the West Bank. The poll, conducted by the Modi'in Ezrachi Institute, also showed that exactly half of those questioned were in favor of a temporary freeze on West Bank settlement activity to enable the start of negotiations with Jordan, while 35,5 percent were against such a settlement halt.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- A resolution in the House calling for the Soviet Union to immediately release Prisoner of Conscience Anatoly Shcharansky and allow him to emigrate to Israel was passed unanimously. The resolution, which was introduced by Rep. Richard Ottinger (D.N.Y.) and which had 219 co-sponsors, also urged President Reagan and Secretary of State George Shultz to raise the issue "in strongest terms" with Soviet officials. The resolution expressed the opinion of the House and does not carry the force of law.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The World Jewish Congress has denied a report in the Wall Street Journal which claimed that it would not participate in the eight day commemoration of the 40th anniversary of the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising to be held in Warsaw. An official for the WJC here said a delegation of six representatives from its executive committee will attend the commemoration. However, WJC president Edgar Bronfman will not go to Warsaw to ensure that the event is not politicized by the Polish government who will officially sponsor the commemoration, the official explained.


