

ONE-DAY ARCHAEOLOGY DIGS ATTRACT ISRAEL BOUND TRAVELERS

NEW YORK, N.Y. -- International travelers who often spend considerable time visiting archaeological excavations can now experience the thrill of the dig itself. DIG-FOR-A-DAY, a new concept under the supervision of Israeli archaeologists, offers the rare opportunity to participate in current excavations in Israel, a country whose soil is rich in 5,000 years of tumultuous history. The DIG-FOR-A-DAY program operates in Jerusalem under the aegis of a company called Promised Land International. A multimedia orientation seminar stressing history and the development of the actual dig site precedes the actual digging. Experienced

archaeologists are on hand for orientation, lessons in the use of excavation tools, and then for the dig itself. DIG-FOR-A-DAY offers the American tourist a unique blend of personal involvement and learning experience in a field heretofore reserved for the specialists.

For the traveler interested in a richer encounter with archaeology, a special two-week program has also been created which highlights dig sites and their archaeological and

historical importance.

Programs for special interest groups focusing on particular topics by historical periods and/or religious denominations can also be arranged.

POTENTIAL WITNESSES AGAINST BARBIE URGED TO CONTACT COMMITTEE IN LYON

LYON, France -- Persons throughout the world who wish to testify or bring evidence against former Nazi official Klaus Barbie have been asked to contact the Coordinating Committee of Jewish Communities and Organizations in Lyon.

Dr. Marc Aron, general secretary of B'nai B'rith District 19 (Western Europe), announced that the Coordinating Committee, with which B'nai B'rith is cooperating, will participate in Barbie's trial "in the name of all the victims, direct or indirect."

The committee, Dr. Aron added, will offer "all material and legal assistance" to those desirous of testifying or who have evidence of Nazi barbarism during the German occupation of France. into negotiations with Israel now.

Israel has a legitimate interest in a stable Lebanon and in the ability of the Lebanese government to prevent terrorist activity from within Lebanon directed against Israel. There cannot be a stable government in Lebanon as long as PLO and Syrian forces remain within its borders. Israel cannot be expected to withdraw its forces from Lebanon except in conjunction with a total withdrawal from the country of all PLO and Syrian forces and the establishment of the necessary safeguards to assure that southern Lebanon will not again become a staging area for terrorist attacks against Israel.

Israel and Lebanon have neither territorial claims against each other nor other outstanding disputes. Therefore, the withdrawal of Israeli forces from Lebanon should be accompanied by the establishment of normal economic, cultural and other relations between the two nations. As recognized at Camp David, security is enhanced by the relationship of peace and cooperation between nations which enjoy normal relations.

The primary requisite for peace in the Middle East is that Israel's neighbors recognize the sovereign legitimacy of Israel and the benefits to be derived from a full peace. We urge them -- particularly Jordan -- to heed President Reagan's call of September 1 to "accept the reality of Israel, and the reality that peace and justice are to be gained only through hard, fair and direct negotiations."
