

HEALTH PLAN OF NEVADA

All Medicare recipients in Las Vegas will receive an announcement from the Health Care Financing Administration explaining the benefits of HMO's, health maintenance organizations.

Health Plan of Nevada is the only health maintenance organization (HMO) in Southern Nevada, serving all of Clark County.

Medicare law allows certain qualified health maintenance organizations such as Health Plan of Nevada to enter into contracts with Medicare. Medicare beneficiaries may then choose to receive Medicare covered health services for a fixed prepaid charge.

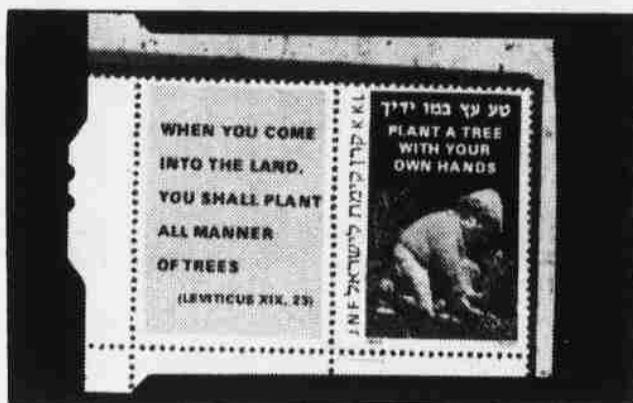
Health Plan of Nevada offers a broad range of comprehensive health care services with an emphasis on preventive care.

Medicare's contract is with Health Plan of Nevada locally.

The information Health Plan of Nevada will send Medicare beneficiaries will include a summary of benefits, facts about their two plans, medical and surgical coverage, and related benefits, prescription drug benefits and complete instructions on obtaining the benefits offered by the program.

NEW JNF STAMP



One of the most popular tourist attractions in Israel is the "Plant a Tree with Your Own Hands" project run by the Jewish National Fund. Thousands of visitors have taken the opportunity to plant a tree in one of the JNF forests, thus personally contributing to the important task of the reforestation and the greening of Israel.

In April 1983, a new stamp issued by the JNF Stamp Department in Jerusalem will commemorate this ongoing project. The stamp features an original and unique

"bread sculpture" of a young boy planting a tree, created by the graphic artist Ruth Levin.

The full-color stamps are issued in sheets of 22 (5 x 4 plus 2) with three different tabs. The tabs contain the quote from Leviticus 19:23 -- "When you come into the land, you shall plant all manner of trees" -- in Hebrew, Arabic and English.

At the same time, another stamp in the National Flag of Israel series will be issued by the JNF Stamp Department. Issued in sheets of six stamps with two different Hebrew tabs, the stamp's colors are blue and purple.

Since 1902, some

4,200 have been issued by various JNF offices in North and South America, Europe and Australia, as well as the main office in Jerusalem.

Today, JNF stamps are valued as philatelic items by collectors of Judaica and other topical subjects. Because they depict famous personalities and events in Jewish and Zionist history, as well as JNF projects in Israel, the stamps are also used extensively for educational purposes. The new issues, as well as older JNF stamps, may be ordered directly from the JNF Stamp Department, P.O.B. 283, 91002 Jerusalem.

NOTICE OF MEDICARE QUALIFIED HEALTH MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION

The Medicare law allows certain qualified health maintenance organizations (HMOs) to enter into contracts with Medicare. A qualified HMO in your area has entered into such a contract. Consequently, as a Medicare beneficiary, you may choose to receive your health care services in one of two ways:

1. You may continue to receive the services covered by Medicare from your present physician and other providers of service exactly as you have in the past, or
2. You may choose to enroll in the HMO shown at the bottom of this notice. If you enroll in the HMO you select a physician from the HMO and receive Medicare services through the HMO.

If you join an HMO, you pay them a monthly fixed amount to cover the costs of deductible and coinsurance under Medicare, and Medicare pays directly to the HMO the balance for covered Medicare services.
