

### TWO ISRAELI SOLDIERS VISITED BY RED CROSS

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- For the first time since their capture by a Palestinian terrorist group last summer, two Israeli soldiers were visited by an International Red Cross representative. An IRC spokesman in Geneva confirmed that the agency's representative in Damascus delivered food parcels and mail to Nissam Salem and Yosef Gross.

The two Israelis, both 21 years old, were captured nine months ago by the

Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command, a breakaway faction of the Palestine Liberation Organization headed by Ahmed Jibril. There are six Israelis still being held by El Fatah, the main faction of the PLO, and have been visited regularly by the IRC and a video-taped interview with them was shown on Jordanian television which is also seen in Israel.

The first proof that Salem and Gross were

alive was contained in a taped interview released several days prior to the IRC visit by the Jibril group to the Austrian government. The Austrian government has worked as an intermediary between the PLO and Israel. In the taped interview with the two Israelis held by the Jibril group, one of the soldiers spoke in English and the other in Hebrew. Both said they were being "properly treated."

The IRC said it

was not the agency's policy to report publicly the state of prisoners or the conditions under which they are held. But it confirmed that the two men were visited by a doctor in addition to the IRC representative and were given news of their families. "The prisoners sent news of themselves to their families via the delegates and the delegates gave each prisoner one parcel from their family," the IRC spokesman said.

### A BIBLE FOR THE PRESIDENT



MURIEL M. BERMAN, PRESIDENT OF THE JEWISH PUBLICATION SOCIETY OF AMERICA, IS GREETED BY PRESIDENT REAGAN AT THE WHITE HOUSE. MRS. ### HERZOG INAUGURATED

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Chaim Herzog was inaugurated as Israel's sixth President in colorful ceremonies at the Knesset. In his inaugural speech, the new chief of state, who was born in Ireland and is a son of the late Chief Rabbi Issac Halevi Herzog of Israel, warned repeatedly against intolerance. "The enemy within," he said, is more dangerous to Israel's survival than any external foe. Herzog recalled the disasters of Jewish history which were caused by internal strife and urged the nation to foster a spirit of unity, tolerance and mutual understanding.

Outgoing President Yitzhak Navon sounded the same theme in his farewell address. He said Israel's various ethnic, religious and national groups lived "with each other but not among each

other." They are ignorant of each others ideas and thoughts and this ignorance breeds intolerance, Navon warned. The incoming and outgoing Presidents, riding in separate limousines, were escorted to the Knesset by motorcycle police and mounted police on white chargers bearing blue pennants. Precisely at dusk, Herzog donned a large black yarmulka, placed his hand on a Bible and took the oath of office.
