**SHAMIR ASKS ABOUT
WHEREABOUTS OF MISSING
JEWS IN ARGENTINA**

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Foreign Minister Yitzhak Shamir has renewed his demand that the government of Argentina provide Israel with information about 340 Jews who have "disappeared" in Argentina.

Shamir submitted to the leaders of Argentina last December a list of 340 "disappeared" Jews and of another 10 known to be in detention and asked for information concerning their fate. To date, he has received information about 33 of them, and eight of the 10 detainees have been released. One of the 33 has emigrated to Israel.

Shamir told Ambassador Roberto Temporini of Argentina that the information received was not sufficient and again demanded information concerning the missing Jews. Temporini pledged his government's "continued efforts" to ascertain the whereabouts of the disappeared persons on Shamir's list. Revealing these

details Shamir said he had told the Ambassador that Israel "could not accept" the Argentine government's statement to the effect that the disappeared persons should be regarded as no longer alive.

Briefing reporters in Jerusalem, Shamir said Temporini's pledge that his government would continue its efforts to provide the details requested by Israel seemed to show that the statement need not be the last word.

Shamir said that Israel's action on behalf of the Jewish "disappeared" was a virtually unprecedented instance of direct diplomatic intervention by the Jewish State on behalf of non-Israeli Jews abroad. But, he said, the Argentine government had not questioned Israel's legitimate interest in the fates of these Jews and had not argued that Israel's demand for information was an unjustified interference.

SUIT FILED AGAINST THREE MEN

WASH. (WNS) -- An organization founded last year to take legal action in support of victims of anti-Semitism has filed a \$6 million suit in a federal court in Brooklyn against three Kings Point, N.Y. men who have "terrorized" a Jewish family in that Long Island town for the last three years.

Irving Shapell, president of the Washington-based Jewish Advocacy Center, said he filed the suit for compensation and punitive damages for Yaacov and Hanna Elkon and their two children, aged six and 11. The suit charges that Brad Barry, Robert Lesser and Brian Kolen went on a three year "rampage of assault, terror and vandalism" against the Elkons "for the simple rea-

son that the Elkons are Jewish." Shapell noted that although similar suits have been filed in the past for Black families, it is the first time it has been done on behalf of a Jewish family.

The complaint filed in federal court charges that the Elkon's home was defaced with swastikas and anti-Semitic slogans; fires were set on their property;

windows were shot out and broken; fireworks were thrown into the house; and anti-Semitic statements against Mrs. Elkon were spray-painted along a public street. The suit alleges that the defendants also placed a voodoo doll in the front yard of the Elkon's home with a Star of David on the doll's chest and a hypodermic syringe piercing the doll's eye.

**GAZA ARABS
SENTENCED FOR
BUS ATTACK**

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Two Gaza Arabs were sentenced to life imprisonment by a military court in Lod for a grenade attack on an Egged bus four months ago in which eight passengers were injured. The defendants, both in their twenties, are residents of the Deir Al Balah village and the Maazi refugee camp. The president of the court said the life sentences were justified because the attack was planned and premeditated with the intention of killing civilians. The two men charged with throwing grenades at the bus as it passed through a sparsely populated area in the southern outskirts of Tel Aviv on a Saturday evening.
