TEMPLE SENIORS LEARN TWO ISRAELI SOLDIERS KILLED IN LEBANON

JERUSALEM (WNS) - Funeral services were held for two Israeli soldiers killed in Beirut a day ear-lier when a boobytrapped car exploded patrol. near their Two other soldiers, slightly injured by the blast, were hospitalized in Haifa. Five Lebanese passers-by also were hurt. The dead soldiers were identified as Sgt. Moshe Edelstein, 31, of Kibbutz Ramat David and Yosef Ben-Or, of Kubbutz Givat Haim, Israeli authorities did not immediately confirm the casualties, first re-ported by Beirut radio. Later, however, they gave details of the incident.

According to a military spokesman, it occurred at about 10 a.m. local time as two Israeli armored personnel carriers were passing through the Galerie Semaan, a busy intersection between east and west Beirut which have been the

scene of several terrorist attacks in recent weeks. The first APC passed safely. The serocked by cond was the explosion of a car less than 10 yards behind it. The car was identified as a Mercedes containing 100 - 200 kilograms of high explosives. Nearby buildings were heavily damaged,

The Israeli army beefed up its security arrangements

immediately after the explosion. Israeli soldiers set up road blocks on the road leading to local headquarters in the Yarze of Beirut. section something they have

rarely done in that part of the city. The perpetrators were not caught. A military spokesman explained that terrorists frequently shoot at Israeli patrols in the Galerie Semaan, which takes its name from a large furniture store.
