JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

NEW YORK (WNS) — The World Jewish Congress announced here that it has moved its world headquarters from Geneva to New York and set up its European office in Paris. Only Dr. Gerhard Reigner, Secretary General of the WJC, and a small staff remain in Geneva, providing representation at the United Nations office there and some involvement in Christian-Jewish relations. Israel Singer, executive director of the WJC said that the move was made "to reflect the realities" of the world Jewish population.

JERUSALEM (WNS) — A suspect held in connection with the murder of two nuns in Jerusalem several months ago has admitted killing them. Police identified the suspect as Alawishes Juro Roberts, a 29-year-old American Indian. He told the judge in Jerusalem court July 27 that his spirit, not his body, committed the crime. The court extended his detention. The two nuns, mother and daughter, were found murdered in the Ein Kerem convent.

LONDON (WNS) — Yehuda Avner, the new Israeli Ambassador to Britain, presented his letter of accreditation to the Queen, accompanied with the letter formally recalling Shlomo Argov, disabled by a terrorist attack in London last year. Avner, 53, is the first British-born Israeli to serve as Ambassador in his native country.

GENEVA (WNS) — Ovadia Soffer, the present Israeli Ambassador to the United Nations in Geneva, has been appointed as the new Israeli Ambassador to France, replacing Meir Rosenne, who was recently appointed to Washington. The 47-year-old Soffer, born in Iraq, was formerly apbassador to Chad and has served at the Israel Mission to the United Nations in New York.

NEW YORK (WNS) — In July, 167 Jews were allowed to leave the Soviet Union with Israeli visas, the National Conference on Soviet Jewry reported. The figure is higher than the monthly average of approximately 100 people per month during the first half of 1983.

JERUSALEM (WNS) — The World Zionist Organization has approved a \$57 million budget for the WZO, \$1.4 million more than last year. Akiva Levinsky, the treasurer, said the largest increases will be for the department responsible for bringing young people to Israel. The youth and hechalutz department received an additional \$400,000 and the two educational departments received an additional \$100,000 each.

TEL AVIV (WNS) — Security guards at the detention camp in Ansar in southern Lebanon have discovered a tunnel being built by the prisoners taken during the Lebanon war, as an escape route. The nearly six foot wide tunnel was about 20 feet long and needed only a few more feet to reach the open ground outside the prison compound. Israel Defense Force soldiers filled it with concrete. Some 5,000 prisoners are at present held within the camp.
