
## Soviets Said To Export Anti-Zionist Propaganda To the U.S.

NEW YORK (WNS) -The National Conference on Soviet Jewry (NCSJ) reported that a new film made by the export abroad, par-ticularly to the United States, links Zionism Nazism and racism. According to the NCSJ, the Film, "Babi Yar: the Lessons of History," is disturbecause to expand the ongoing Soviet propaganda campaign personified by the three-and-a-half month old "Anti-Zionist

Committee."

Narrated flawless English and of high technical quality, it was apparently sent Soviet government for out to a wide variety of media outlets, in-cluding CBS NEWS, the Simon Wiesenthal Center and private in-dividuals involved in tracking down Nazi war criminals.

The danger of the it film. the NCSJ represents an attempt stressed, is that it has been well targeted. Its anti-Zionist message is subtle compared to that in Soviet propaganda geared for internal consumption: only a few telltale lines, uttered in a steady, matter-of-fact tone, are inserted into the roughly hour-long film. They appear, moreover, within the context of repeated admonitions "Never again," and "We must never forget" -phrases which strike a chord in any Jew, and doubtless many others in the West.
