## Las Vegas Israelite **Jewish Parents Thrilled 'Golda' School Offers** 7-12th Grade Quality Education In Southern California

"I didn't know there was such a school for my kids," say many parents when they discover a refreshing new alternative to public or nonsectarian private schools; or as the logical continuation after Conservative Jewish Day School in the Southern California area.

GOLDA MEIR SCHOOL has Junior and Senior High School Divisions, 7th through 12th grades inclusive. It offers a top-quality, college-prep education for boys and girls, at low cost to any Jewish parent who truly wishes to give their child a personalized education -- with a commitment to excellence and strong attention to the individual.

"Project Et Gar" is Golda's drive to increase enrollment. "Et Gar" means "challenge" in Hebrew, "Challenge" is the key motivation for Golda's 111 fortunate students who enjoy the finest accredited teachers, and a complete English-Jewish combined program, which totally eliminates the need for afternoon Hebrew School.

Golda Meir School's Junior High Division (grades 7-8-9) has tripled enrollment in one year (1982 to 1983) from 17 to 54 children, with the remaining 57 students in the Senior High School Division (grades 10-11-12).

"Golda," as the students, faculty and parents affectionately call their school "family," is located at 15,600 Mulholland Drive, Belair, just off the San Diego Freeway in the West Los Angeles area. Tuition is \$3,500 annually, but no Jewish parent needing some financial assistance is turned away, so long as you truly care about your child's education, future happiness and success.

Parents of 6th graders are especially eager to learn more about Golda's English-Jewish combined program, but students in any grade 7-12 may enrol

The hand-picked faculty (all accredited teachers with top degrees) conducts very small classes (10 to 20), with both a Regular and an Honors Program. There are four "solid" Jewish courses each year (beginning to advanced Hebrew, Jewish bible and texts, and Jewish ideas, culture and values). Electives include art, typing, etc. Physical Education is mandatory.

In addition to stimulating courses, the children visit places like Yosemite National Park for five days, and tour science and history museums. A typical school project might be to bring gifts to Jewish orphanages, schools or rest homes.

Golda Meir School has an "international flavor." About half are American, while the balance consists of students from Israel, Iran, Russia, Europe, South America, and other exotic lands.

So far, while students (for 7th grade or higher) "feed" into Golda from many types of schools, the majority have enrolled from Conservative Jewish Day Schools. Many, but not all, are from the San Fernando Valley area. Whether a child speaks no Hebrew, or speaks fluent Hebrew, there is a challenging and rewarding co-ed program at Golda, one-third Judaic studies, twothirds English/general studies.

The Senior High was established in 1979, while the Junior High reported a 300% increase in enrollment in its second year! Classes are small, instruction is highly personalized, and frequent communication between parent and teacher is stressed.

New (prospective) parents and students are invited to visit for a day or more, by appointment, to see first-hand the warm, friendly, congenial children and faculty, who are eager to accept each new child in the Golda "family."

Each new student is thoroughly tested to

determine his or her exact ability in each subject, and then placed at the appropriate level for maximum challenge and results. Virtually every student plans to attend college, so the entire program is geared for college preparation in every course.
