Russian Jews - "Reviled, Restricted and Rejected BUT NOT ALLOWED TO LEAVE..."

Under the present Soviet regime, the position of Jews has worsened. Andropov's Jewish policy, according to B'nai B'rith Soviet expert William Korey, is four fold: 1. to end emigration entirely; 2. to cut Soviet Jews off from their co-religionists abroad; 3. to intensify enforced assimilation; and 4. to carry out an Anti-Zionist, Anti-Semitic campaign.

"Soviet Jewry is not exclusively a Jewish concern, it is an AMERICAN ISSUE. The rights of cultural and religious minorities, freedom from economic and political discrimination, and the ability to emigrate from the country of one's birth are mainstays of the American tradition."

Seniors Find Support



Due to severe cutbacks in funding, many senior activities have had to be curtailed. The Economic Opportunity Board's operation of 18 mini-buses which are used to transport the elderly and handicapped is in danger of having to sharply reduce services unless they can raise private funds.

Health Plan of Nevada, the only health maintenance organization (HMO) in our state, recently showed its support of the EOB's transportation services by purchasing advertising space on their mini-buses in the form of attractive mylar screens from Energy Directions which are affixed to the vehicles windows (see photo). Forty percent of all advertising costs go directly to the EOB for bus maintenance. The mylar film reduces glare making buses cooler and more pleasant to ride in and, from HPN's point of view, the handsome signs will help to get their message, "We Keep You Healthy" across to the Las Vegas Community.

These buses serve many locations including transport to Health Plan's own Primary Care Center and to HPN Family Practice Physicians and Specialists. It is an advantage to the entire community to keep these vehicles in operation, and Health Plan of Nevada is delighted to return to Las Vegas some of the support they have en-

joyed. Their Medicare Benefits Plan has been very well received and they are the fastest growing system of medical care services in Clark County with over 12,000 members to date.

For example, Hebrew is taught at five different levels, for children with no background to a special program for those with families speaking Hebrew fluently.

Of the 111 total students (expected to increase substantially next year), 43% came from public schools, 37% from community (conservative) Jewish Day Schools (which usually end at 6th grade), 11% from Orthodox Day Schools, and the remainder from either secular private schools, or arrivals from Israel, Iran or other countries.
