# MOSCOW WEDDING



71-year-old refusenik Abe Stolar (L), an American citizen trapped in the USSR since the 1930s, looks somber as he helps hold a tallit as a wedding chuppah over his son Michael and daughter-in-law Julia during a recent unofficial religious ceremony in his Moscow apartment. The photo was obtained by the Student Struggle for Soviet Jewry and Colorado Committee of Concern. Abe, his wife Gita and Michael had received permission to emigrate to Israel in 1975, but as they walked to the plane they were suddenly told that their visas had been cancelled. Abe is a World War II veteran. A special list of refusenik war veterans in Russia to whom to write is available free from the SSSJ, 210 West 91st Street, New York, N.Y. 10024.
