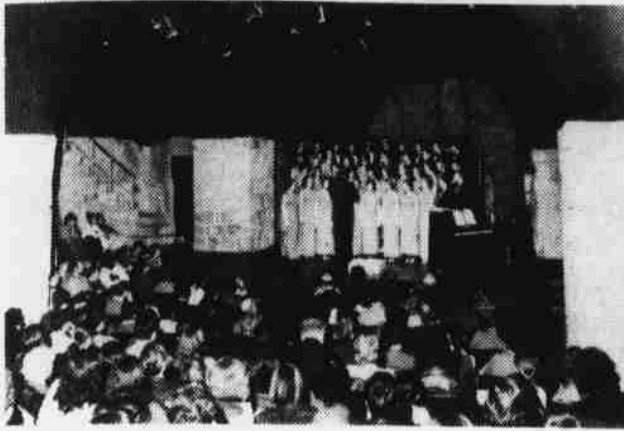


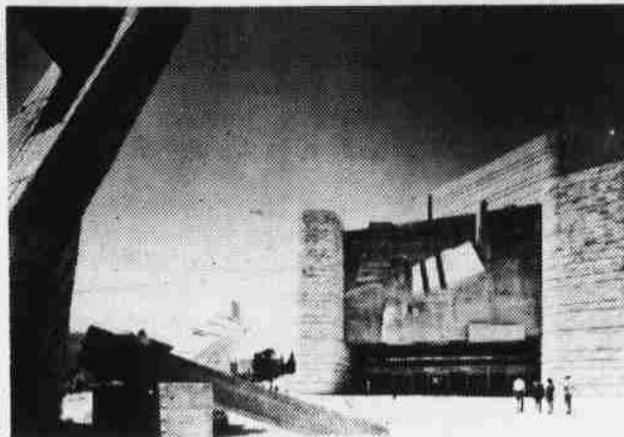
# All-Star 'Israel Festival' Planned For Summer — 1984



**JERUSALEM, ISRAEL:** - An American choir performs at Jerusalem's KHAN Theater; the 1984 ISRAEL FESTIVAL will take place in Jerusalem from May 18 to June 17 with an array of internationally renowned actors, singers, musicians, orchestras, theatre and opera companies, dancers and ballet troupes. The unique KHAN Theater was originally an eighteenth century Turkish "Caravanseral" (Coaching Inn), converted to use as an entertainment complex in the 1960's.

**NEW YORK, N.Y.:** - The 1984 ISRAEL FESTIVAL of music, dance, opera and drama promises to bring travelers to Jerusalem an exotic, all-star series of attractions, second only to Britain's annual Edinburgh Festival. The ISRAEL FESTIVAL will take place in Jerusalem from May 18 to June 17, 1984.

A host of international and Israeli performers and companies will appear at the annual festival - performances of which will take place in Jerusalem's magnificent open-air Sultan's Pool amphitheatre - in the valley beneath the floodlit Old City walls; in the courtyard of David's Citadel; at the theatre on Mount Scopus with its

stunning view of the desert and Dead Sea - and at the city's modern theatres and concert halls. Beyond the actual performances will be a host of attractions in the streets of downtown Jerusalem: clowns, acrobats, mimes, parades and street-theatre.

- CONNAISSANCE DU THEATRE Company from Paris, performing Offenbach operettas.

- BERLIN PHILHARMONIC'S CHAMBER ORCHESTRA.
- PINCHAS ZUCKERMAN and the ST. PAUL ORCHESTRA.
- MUNICH'S TOLZER KNABEN CHOIR: Performing the "Shabbat Cantata" and "The Ten Plaques."
- VICTORIA DE LOS ANGELES performing songs in Ladino.
- MOMIX DANCE THEATRE, U.S.A.
- BRANDEIS QUARTER; AMADEUS TRIO; BERLIN OCTET.
- MARTHA ARGERICK (Piano) and IVRY GITLIS (Violin).
- LA CUADRA DE SEVILLA Theatre Company.
- NEW BABYLON - The 1928 Russian silent film, accompanied by a full symphony orchestra playing the Shostakovich score.

Additionally, there will be performances by musicians, dance and theatre companies from Israel, Spain, Scotland, Japan, Poland, Italy, England, Denmark, South Africa and the United States.
