

MONTREAL (WNS) Prime Minister Pierre Elliott Trudeau and Conservative opposition leader Brian Mulroney dissociated themselves from the meeting seven mem-bers of the Canadian Parliament had with Palestine Liberation Organization chief Yasir Arafat in Amman, Jordan, recently. The MPs are on a Middle East tour sponsored by the Arab League.

The Prime Minister's Office and Trudeau had not sanctioned the 10day trip which the MPs, Liberal and Conservatives, made in their private capacities. An aide to Mulroney said he was not aware of the trip. The meeting was angrily denounced by Canadian Jewish groups.
