A jubilant Board of Directors of Congregation Shaarei Tefilla announced the closing of escrow and the purchase of the building being used as the Synagogue at 1331 S. Maryland Parkway.

President Jack Super comments, "After three years of renting, we now have a permanent home for Congregation Sharei Tefilla. Thanks to the generosity of the entire Jewish community and out-of-town visitors, we were able to purchase the property. We will now expand the present facilities so as to accommodate the increasing numbers of people attending our services."

The Orthodox Synagogue was formed three years ago by a handful of people. It has now grown to 30 member families. Services are held daily at 7:30 a.m., on Shabbat at 8:30 a.m., and on Sunday at 9:00 a.m. Hebrew School and Bar Mitzvah training is available and there is an active Sisterhood. Congregation Shaarei Tefilla is a member of the Union of Orthodox Synagogues of America and conducts all its services in the traditional Orthodox manner.

7 Canadian Solons Meet With Arafat In Amman

MONTREAL (WNS) — Prime Minister Pierre Elliott Trudeau and Conservative opposition leader Brian Mulroney dissociated themselves from the meeting seven members of the Canadian Parliament had with Palestine Liberation Organization chief Yasir Arafat in Amman, Jordan, recently. The MPs are on a Middle East tour sponsored by the Arab League.

The Prime Minister's Office and Trudeau had not sanctioned the 10-day trip which the MPs, Liberal and Conservatives, made in their private capacities. An aide to Mulroney said he was not aware of the trip. The meeting was angrily denounced by Canadian Jewish groups.

According to the Arab League office in Ottawa, Arafat urged

the MPs to press the Canadian government to officially recognize the PLO. An Arab League spokesman, Yassar Askari, said the MPs represented the Canada-Arab World Parliamentary Group consisting of more than 70 MPs and Senators.

Frank Diamant, executive vice president of B'nai B'rith in Canada, said: "I am exceptionally disappointed that the members of Parliament who represent Canada would meet with a terrorist. It is particularly disappointing that they would meet with Arafat on a day that he has taken credit for ordering an explosive device to go off in a shopping center in Jerusalem." Two grenades exploded outside a shop in West Jerusalem, recently.
