An exhibition and auction of Israeli art is to be held in Continental Hotel, Las Vegas, Sunday, March 18, 1984 at 2:00 p.m.

The event is being staged through the cooperation of the Israeli Artists Organization and Israeli's Ministry of Commerce, and Temple Beth Shalom-Las Vegas.

The exhibition, which is to be followed by an auction of artworks, is being brought to this country and Las Vegas by Baruch Kutany, a representative of Israeli Artists Organization. It is the largest art exhibit by Israeli artists ever brought to the United States. Over 700 pieces-Impressionist, Abstract Expressionist, Art Nouveaux, Modern, Art Deco, Sculptures, Enamels and others.

Among the large collection are original works by Reuven Rubin, Marc Chagall, Agam, Tobiasse, Shmuel Katz and Liberman. Also, many of the other international masters, like Dali, Miro, Picasso, Vassarely and Boulanger. There will

Soviet Jew Ends Hunger Strike

NEW YORK (WNS) — Leningrad activist Nadezhda Frodkova has ended her two-month hunger strike, it was reported by the National Conference on Soviet Jewry. Frodkova, 36, had been forced in a Leningrad hospital since she began her strike on December 26.

According to the Conference, she first applied for an exit visa in 1978 but was refused because Soviet authorities claimed that her father was engaged in security work as a deputy director of the Leningrad construction bureau. The Conference noted, however, that Frodkova's parents had divorced when she was six months old and that she has never had close contact with her father.

Frodkova graduated in 1968 from Leningrad University with a degree in mathematical

linguistics. After she was first refused an exit visa in 1978 she reapplied again at various times but was refused each time. She protested by staging hunger strikes.
