U.S. Withdraws Proposed Sale Of Missiles To Jordan & Saudi Arabia

WASHINGTON (WNS) — Amid growing Congressional opposition, President Reagan has withdrawn his proposal to sell 1,613 Stinger anti-aircraft missiles to Jordan and 1,200 to Saudi Arabia, the White House announced recently.

The State Department said the decision was made after an "assessment of the legislative situation" in which Sen. Bob Packwood (R. Ore.) had gathered 55 signatures on a letter to Reagan opposing the Stinger sale, more than half of the Republican

Israel Steps Up Security After Terrorist Attack In Jerusalem

JERUSALEM (WNS) — Israel closed the Awali River bridge in south Lebanon and the border crossing along the international boundary with Lebanon following reports that Israeli security sources learned that the three terrorists responsible for the gun and grenade attack in Jerusalem had entered Israel through the Rosh Hanikra border crossing point from south Lebanon.

Defense Minister Moshe Arens warned Syria that Israel will not tolerate a "war of attrition." He also said while touring the eastern sector of the

Passover Marvel

(The following information was gathered from the Columbia Encyclopedia, The Story of Pesach published by a commercial matzoh company, and Tolstoi.)

How much can be added to a story that has been commemorated and told in every Jewish family during the annual Seder? True, each year the ceremonial portion of the traditional party dwindles, while the menu for the feast keeps expanding in proportion to the new products that hit the market, labeled Kosher for Passover. The soup-to-nuts Seder now includes canned soups, frozen meats, all flavors of soda pop, many kinds of candy and after-dinner mints - all legitimately in keeping with Passover dietary laws, and stylish.
