54 Solons Urge IOC To Deny Any **PLO Application To Olympic Games**

WASHINGTON (WNS) - At the initiative of Rep. Mel Levine (D. Calif.), the International Olympic Committee (IOC) has been urged in a letter signed by 54 members of the House to reject any application the Palestine Liberation Organization to participate in the 1984 Olympic Games in Los Angeles.

Declaring that "recognition of the PLO" by the IOC "would be morally repugnant and inconsistent with the International Olympic Committee's charter," the letter, stated: "The PLO represents neither a geographical area nor the Palestinian people."
