

## **U.S. Labor Secretary Raymond Donovan Visits ORT** School of Engineering in Jerusalem

During a recent visit to Israel, U.S. Labor Secretary Raymond Donovan toured the ORT School of Engineering in Jerusalem where he examined the ORT training programs in computer technology, robotics and laser operations, according to American ORT Federation President Alvin

volved in high technology, including 30,000 scientists and engineers and 185,000 skilled technical workers. Only 14% of the work force of the United States is involved in hi-tech fields.

## Saudi Warns U.S. On Moving Embasy

- Saudi Arabia's Ambassador to the United States warned against moves in Congress to relocate the American Embassy in Israel from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem. In an appearance before the Washington Press Club, Prince Bandor Bin-Sultan also warned that if the U.S. refuses to sell weapons to Arab countries they will purchase their arms in the Soviet Union, England, or France.

Calling on the U.S. to play a more even-handed role in the Middle East, Bandar said "We believe strongly that no change should be done in the Jerusalem situation" until the status of the city
