Judge Pavlikowski Will Run Again



District Judge Joseph Pavlikowski has announced his candidacy for a fourth term on the bench. Pavlikowski, 55, was elected to his first term on the District Court bench in 1970. He was unopposed in runs for his second and third terms in 1974 and 1978.

The judge is a thirty-year resident of Las Vegas and has been a member of the Nevada Bar Association since 1961. The bulk of his legal career in Nevada has been dedicated to the public.

Pavlikowski served four years as a deputy city attorney before moving on to the Justice Court

Jack Jeffrey Seeks Re-election

Assembly majority leader, Jack Jeffrey, chairman of the Commerce Committee, announced today he will seek re-election to a sixth term as representative of District 22.

The district includes portions of Henderson, all of Boulder City, Searchlight, Nelson and Laughlin.

The 45-year-old Henderson Democrat, who opposed increasing the state sales tax during the 1981 legislative session, said he "sees no reason to expect tax in-



creases during the 1985 legislative session."

Jeffrey is the eighth most senior member of the Assembly. He compiled a 100 percent at-

bench in Las Vegas Township. Twice the judge was elected a Justice of the Peace before being voted into District Court.

"As a Justice of the Peace and as a District Court Judge I have given the citizens of this state and this county experience, fair judgment and dedication to the job," said Pavlikowski.

"That is the only way I know to do the job and I do not intend to change. I am running on my record — a record of which I am proud."

Pavlikowski is married to the former Betty Cummings. The couple has three children and two grandchildren.

Pavlikowski is a graduate of the Washington College of Law, American University. He did his under graduate work at Notre Dame and St. Bonaventure.

The judge flew 125 combat missions as a United States Air Force pilot during the Korean war.

He currently holds membership in the Veterans of Foreign Wars and American Legion. He is also a member of the Elks Club.

tendance record last session and has been present for 4,384 of 4,387 votes during six sessions.

During the 1983 legislature, Jeffrey authored successful legislation to expand the Public Service Commission from three to five members and supported legislation increasing penalties for crimes against the elderly, tougher child pornography laws and punishment for participation in criminal syndicates. He also supported expanded programs for tourism and economic development.

Jeffrey was chairman of the subcommittee which developed Nevada's strong fire safety and retrofitting law during the 1981 session following the fires at the MGM and Hilton Hotels.

During the 1979 session, Jeffrey successfully pressed for \$1.9 million for the Henderson Community College.

He has also supported repeal of the sales tax of food and the personal property tax, and is a longtime opponent of any legislation which

would consolidate local governments without a vote of the people.

In addition to serving as chairman of the Commerce Committee and Majority Floor Leader, Jeffrey served on the Government Affairs committee studying parole policies, and is a member of the legislative ethics committee.

"Health care costs remain one of the major challenges in the future," Jeffrey said. "I supported legislation requiring the insurance commissioner to employ a specialist in containing the costs of health care, a patients bill of rights and legislation requiring hospitals to itemize charges in more understandable language."

Jeffrey is a former Henderson city councilman and mayor pro-tem. He served on the St. Rose de Lima Hospital board, Eldorado Valley Advisory group, Regional Streets and Highways Commission and the Las Vegas Convention Authority.

Jeffrey and his wife, Betty, live at 340 Chaparral Drive. They have three children.
