Condemn All Terrorism

The recent upsurge in terrorist attacks and attempted attacks in Israel from both Jewish and Palestinian extremists is a particularly disturbing and troubling development, especially when the victims are innocent civilians far removed from the military and political battlefield.

Equally unsettling was last week's mass arrest of some 20 Israelis allegedly involved in an attempted sabotage of a fleet of Arab owned buses. Details remain sketchy as the government has clamped a news blackout on the case. But acts of Jewish terrorism shames the Jewish state and all world Jewry.

The latest incident in the recent series of Jewish attacks on Arabs in Israel was the placing of bombs under the carriages of six Arab owned buses in East Jerusalem. The operating routes of the buses would have been from the center of East Jerusalem to the Arab village of Kaladiya on the northern outskirts.

Premier Yitzhak Shamir was correct when he credited the police with preventing a disaster of major proportions since the bombs were scheduled to detonate during the afternoon rush.

Latest reports have suggested that the arrested group of Jewish extremists may have been involved in other attacks on Arabs, including the bombing and maiming of two West Bank Arab mayors in 1980 and the attack last summer on the Islamic College in Hebron in which three Arab students were killed.

While the arrested individuals will be afforded all the legal rights they are entitled under the laws of the state, Israeli officials have acknowledged that the prospect of an underground Jewish terrorist group is a particularly ominous development. And that acknowledgement has come from a huge cross section of politicians; both from right and left of the political spectrum.

World Jewry must affirm their commitment to the high standard of Jewish morality and a vision of cooperation and peace among its fellow neighbors in the Middle East and indeed throughout the world. Jewish terrorist acts can only act as a divisive factor and exacerbate tensions in the region. The actions by Jewish extremists are no less awful than those committed against Jews by the Palestine Liberation Organization.

Battle Vs. International Terrorism Thwarted By UN Automatic Majority

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) — For many years now this world organization has shown itself impotent

in dealing with the peril of international terrorism.

The reason for this failure is simple.

The very agenda item on this subject is contradictory in its composition. The item begins clearly enough and addresses itself to the subject. It reads: "Measures to prevent international terrorism which endangers or takes innocent human lives or jeopardizes fundamental freedoms..."

But then it concludes with this clause nullifying the entire item:

"...and study of the underlying causes of those forms of terrorism and acts of violence which lie in misery, frustration, grievance and despair and which cause some people to sacrifice human lives, including their own, in an attempt to effect radical changes..."

Here in this latter phrase, which kills the item, we have a justification of all the murders, assassinations and hijackings perpetrated by the PLO and other notorious terrorists claiming to represent "liberation" movements around the world.

It goes without saying that the automatic majority here -- dominated by the Soviet-Arab-third world blocs which include such states as Libya, Syria, Algeria, Iran, Iraq, etc. -- had prevailed upon the drafters of this item to frame it in the manner we have seen so as to give a green light to the terrorists who enjoy the support of and are financed by the radical UN members.

Proof of this lies in the fact that when this item was first included on the agenda of the 27th session in 1972, the Assembly elected an Ad Hoc Committee of 35 to deal with the issue. And lo and behold, among the members of this Committee we find none others than Algeria, Iran, Syria, the USSR, the two Yemens, Hungary, Tunisia, India and Yugoslavia.

It is difficult, then, to envisage the UN accomplishing anything constructive in the battle against international terrorism. This may be one of the reasons why the United States, in the aftermath of the tragic situation at the Libyan Embassy in London, sent four bills to Congress aimed against this escalating plague which strikes against innocent civilians, as it struck Jerusalem recently.

To be effective in combatting global terrorism, it is imperative that Washington win the support and cooperation of its NATO allies, especially Britain, France and Italy. Now that Britain has experienced the terror of the murderers and severed its relations with Libya, she may join the U.S. in some coordinated effort to stem terrorists acts globally. Italy and France, which still enjoy a heavy trade with Libya and other Arab states who harbor and finance terrorists, might hesitate to participate in an all-out anti-international terrorist campaign such as Washington now anticipates.

It is the view of this writer that unless the NATO states join forces with the United States in such a campaign to eradicate global terrorism, the task will prove difficult. The NATO countries must realize that the peril which terrorism poses to them is great and could be fatal. Indeed, if unchecked, it

may jeopardize the democratic world. It all boils down to a conflict between NATO and the Warsaw Pact combine, between Democracy and Totalitarianism. Biblically speaking, it is "Babylon" versus "Israel," in all its twelve tribes, resurrected again.

Next week we shall see where the Soviet linkage with the PLO serves as a "vehicle for exporting terrorism and destabilization" as based upon a new work entitled "Terrorism: The Soviet Connection."

JERUSALEM (WNS) — About 350 businessmen and industrialists from all over the world have confirmed their participation in an international economic conference to be held in Jerusalem May 20. The conference was called in an effort to boost foreign investments in Israel. The participants were described as business leaders who head companies with annual turnovers of over \$100 million.

BONN (WNS) — The Green Party has expelled one of its founding members, Tristan Abromeit, on grounds that he supports Nazi ideas. He is the fourth party official to resign or to leave his post because of alleged Nazi sympathies. The Green Party, based in Lower Saxony, is a coalition of pacifists and ecologists and a member of the opposition in the Bundestag. Abromeit, 50, has found himself increasingly out of tune with the party's guiding principles in recent years.

It helps fund four youth groups locally of over 100 kids ages 13 through 17 and helps supply the budget for Hillel unit at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. A major portion of the monies raised from the Man of the Year remain in the Las Vegas community.
