# Israeli Delegation Assembles In Morocco

## Albany Basement Yields Rediscovery Of Nuremberg Documents

ALBANY, N.Y. (WNS) — A total of 144 crates of documents from the Nuremberg Tribunals on Nazi war criminals, which had been gathering dust since the late 1940's in the basement of the State Cultural Education Center here, was recently rediscovered.

Preliminary investigations have established that the documents are one of some 20 mimeographed sets now housed in libraries, documentation centers and universities in the United States and

Europe, according to Martin Sullivan, the State Department's Assistant Commissioner for State Museum Science and Historical services.

The documents consist of 12 trial manuscripts of major war criminals. Included are minutes books, official court files, order and judgment books, clemency petitions, prosecution and defense exhibits, and prosecution and defense document books.

According to John Mendelsohn, one of the

## Marking First National Conference

RABAT (WNS) — Some 500 participants and observers from abroad, including prominent French and American Jews, and most significant, a 35 member Israeli delegation, 11 of whom are Knesset members representing both the Likud-led government coalition and the opposition Labor Alignment, gathered here for two days for the first national conference of Moroccan Jewish communities.

The guests were invited with the consent of King Hassan and were the first Israeli group to visit an Arab League member state. This raised hope and cautious speculation during the two day conference that Morocco may soon launch an initiative for a Middle East peace with Israel. Interior Minister Driss Basri and Minister of State Moulay Ahmed Alaoui addressed the conference. The leader of the Israeli delegation, Labor MK Rafael Edri, invited King Hassan to visit Israel.

Basri and Alaoui stressed in their speeches the need for dialogue between Jews and Arabs and
