Shamir, Arens Voice Concern

JERUSALEM (WNS) - Premier Yitzhak Shamir voiced Israel's strong opposition to the United States decision to sell Saudi Arabia 400 Stinger shoulder fired anti-aircraft missiles to be used by the Saudis to protect their oilfields and shipping in the Persian Gulf where the Iran-Iraq war has escalated.

Shamir made his remarks to the Cabinet two days before the Reagan Administration formally
