U.S. Withdraws Request For Funds For Jordanian Strike Force

Reagan Administration has withdrawn its request for Congressional approval for a \$220 million plan to arm and equip a Jordanian strike force, pending review, State Department spokesman John announced Hughes that Congress was asked to defer action "without prejudice" following consultations between the U.S. and Jordan.


