World Jewish Congress President Addresses Conference In Morocco

The meeting, held in mid-May, was notable for the presence of leading Jewish figures from Israel -- including Moroccan-born Knesset members led by Tami Party Leader Aharon Abu-hatzeira. In his address, Mr. Bronfman asked in part: "Here in Morocco under the humanitarian King Hassan II, Jew and Arab have set an example, for all the world to see, of living in peace together." Crown Prince Hassan attended the Conference's closing dinner. Mr. Bronfman was invited to return to Morocco to meet King Hassan and plans to do so shortly.
