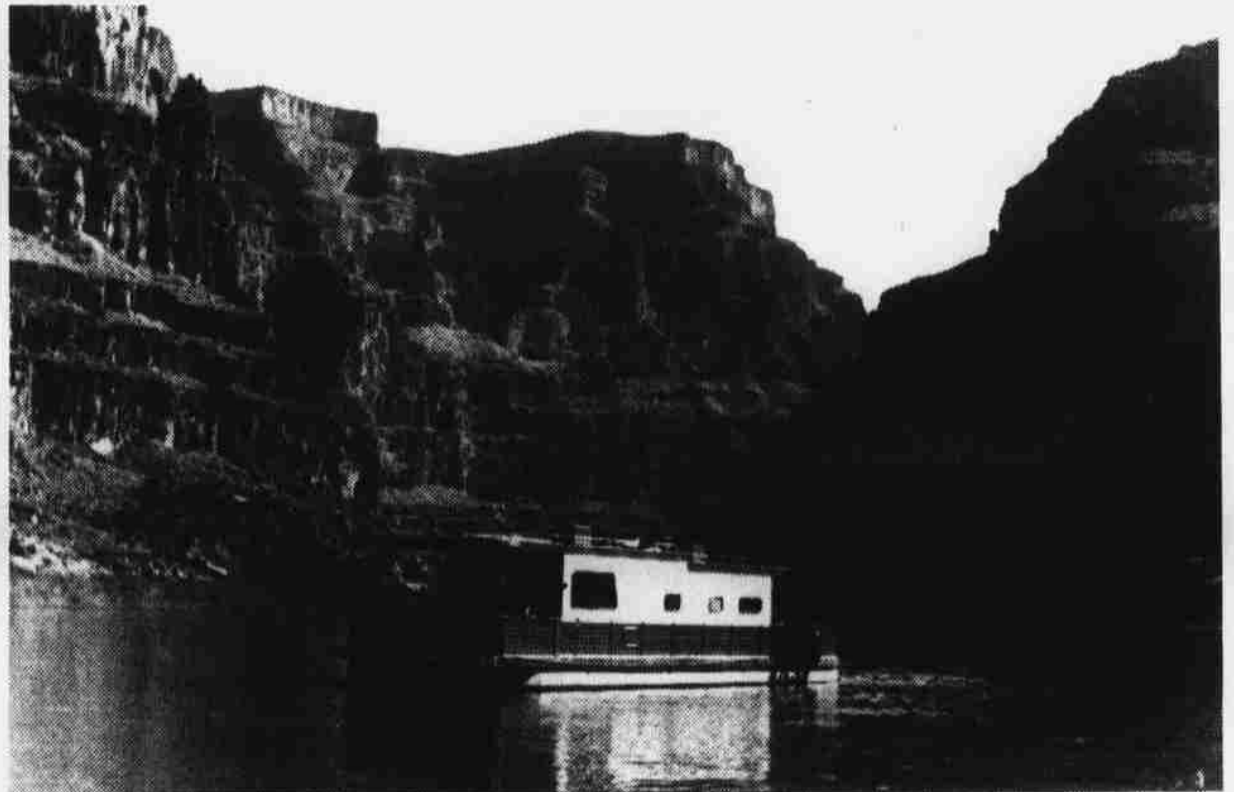

**Jerry Lewis Gearing  
Up For Telethon '84**

Jerry Lewis, host of the annual Labor Day Telethon, is in high gear getting ready for this year's show. The 21 1/2-hour fund raiser to benefit the Muscular Dystrophy Association (MDA) will air live from Caesars Palace in Las Vegas starting Sunday, September 2, at 6:00 P.M.

The veteran comedian, screen actor, writer and director will be joined throughout the show by three top celebrities. Television personality Ed McMahon will mark his twelfth consecutive year as Jerry's Telethon anchorman. The multi-talented Sammy Davis, Jr., and Casey Kasem, host of the world's most-listened-to radio program, "American Top 40," will encore their bravura co-host performances of last year.

The Telethon is a Labor Day tradition. It's a vital part of our national holiday. The Telethon offers Americans the chance to support MDA and watch the biggest live variety show on television.

Telethon '84 will be a star-studded extravaganza featuring top entertainers from every area of show business. Among the top talent scheduled to appear are Liberace; Ann-Margret; George Burns; David Hasselhoff of the hit-TV series "Knight Rider;" Joe Piscopo, "Saturday Night Live" headliner; country music greats Freddie Fender and B.J. Thomas; and comics Milton Berle and Bill Cosby.

MDA is a national voluntary health agency that supports worldwide research and a nationwide network of some 240 hospital-affiliated clinics where people with any of the 40 neuromuscular diseases covered by MDA's programs receives medical care and equipment at no direct cost to them or their families.

**Linkage To Israel  
And Syrian  
Withdrawal Ruled  
Out By Assad**

PARIS (WNS) — President Hafez Assad of Syria said in an interview published in Le Monde that he has ruled out a linkage between the withdrawal of his own forces and an Israeli withdrawal from Lebanon. He said "the two things have nothing in common. We (the Syrians) have come to Lebanon at the request of the Lebanese government while Israel invaded the country."

He claimed, in his interview with Le Monde's senior editor, Andre Fontaine, that "both the Israelis and the Americans understand the reasons for our refusal to link the two withdrawals." Assad said in his view it would be best to deal with Lebanon apart from the rest of the Middle East problem.

Assad charged that America "carries out a policy laid down by Israel." He said Israel is not the tool of the U.S., as many Arabs charge, but that the contrary is true. He also accused President Francois Mitterrand of France of being pro-Israel and of having interfered in Lebanese internal affairs.
