Leo A. Wilner, recently retired Executive Director of Temple Beth Shalom, will host a group trip to Amsterdam and Israel this fall.

Leo was the dynamic force behind the scenes in the dramatic growth of Temple Beth Shalom from August 1, 1966 until his retirement last month. The Temple Board of Directors has granted Leo the honorary title of Executive Director Emeritus, and both he and his wife Mickey have been declared Honorary members of the Temple for life.

The Wilner's 14 day trip will spend 4 days in Amsterdam visiting the Old Jewish Quarter, the Tower Of Tears, Rembrandt's House, the Royal Palace and the home of Anne Frank. Amsterdam known as the Venice of the north is crisscrossed by canals and the trip will include a journey through the waterways.

After bidding Amsterdam a fond farewell the group will proceed to Israel, the land of milk and honey. The group will spend 10 days exploring this dynamic country from Beer Sheeva in the South to the Galilee in the North. Comprehensive sightseeing will be included in all parts of the country. The group has been granted special permission to visit the Knesset in session, a feature not usually included in tours.

Deluxe hotels in all areas, plus a 2 night stay at the 4 star Kibbutz Ayelet Hashacar will provide the participants with comfortable accommodations throughout.
