N.Y. Philharmonic Cancels Trip To Malaysia

NEW YORK (WNS) -The New York Philharmonic Orchestra has dropped plans to perform in Malaysia after a storm of protest from American Jewish leaders and political figures here to the Philharmonic's bowing to the request of the Malaysian government to drop the work of a Jewish composer from its scheduled program.

But after bowing to the Malaysian request, the Orchestra and Citibank, which is sponsoring the Philharmonic's Asian tour, were deluged with criticism and decided to cancel the scheduled stop-over in Malaysia. Outraged leaders Jewish and political figures blasted Malaysian request cultural blackmail, reminiscent of Nazi book-burning, cultural anti-Semitism. Some of the critics later praised the Philharmonic after it announced that it would not perform in Malaysia.
