

Speaker Of The House, Thomas O'Neill, To Be Honored At Israel Bonds Leadership Conference In Boston

The Speaker of the U.S. House of Representatives, Thomas P. O'Neill, Jr., will be honored for his more than three decades of public service and support for Israel during the 1984 Israel Bond National Leadership Conference to be held in Boston from Thursday, September 13 to Sunday, September 16, it has been announced by David B. Hermelin, National Campaign Chairman.

The conference, which will be held at the Park Plaza Hotel, will be attended by more than 300 Jewish leaders from the United States and Canada. They will plan a major program of increased Bond activities to mobilize development funds for Israel to help overcome its current economic difficulties.

Also taking part in the conference will be U.S. Senator Edward Kennedy who will accept the Bond

Organization's Truman Centennial Award posthumously for the late President John F. Kennedy at the conference dinner.

Other prominent participants will include Ambassador Meir Rosenne, Israel's Ambassador to the United States, who will report on current developments in Israel and Dr. Martin Feldstein, former Chairman of President Reagan's Council of Economic Advisers, who will brief conference delegates on the American and Israeli economies.
