

# Alvin Benedict Named Foundation Chairman Of Nathan Adelson Hospice



The chairman of the board of MGM Grand Hotels, Inc. has been named founding chairman of

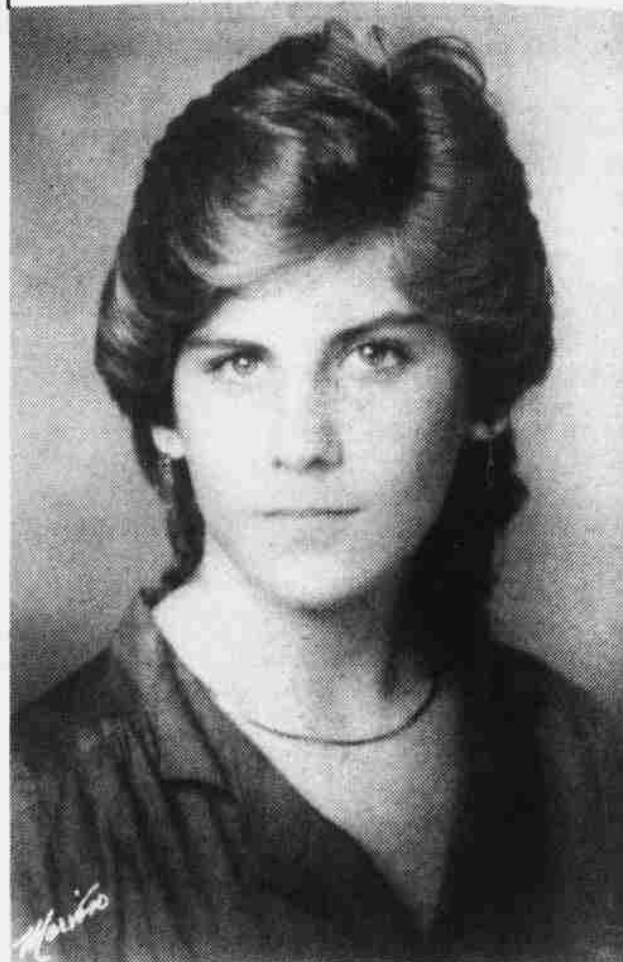
Active in community affairs, Benedict is past president and a director of the Las Vegas Variety Club. He also sits on the Nathan Adelson Hospice board.

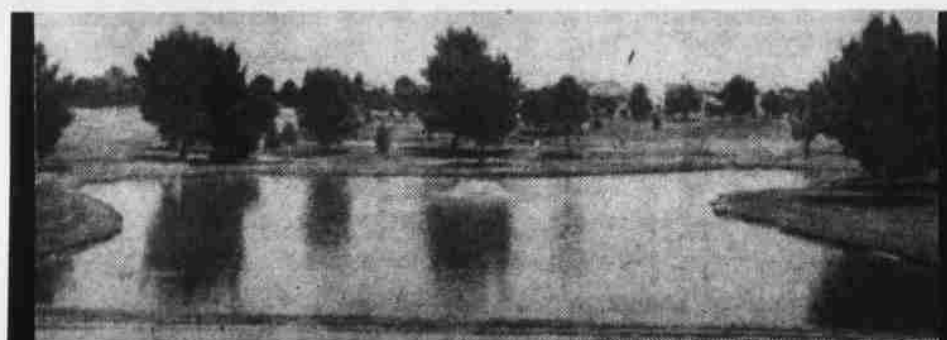
