## Kidnap Victim Still Missing

TEL AVIV (WNS) — The whereabouts of the kidnapped leader of the west Beirut Jewish community Selim Jammous, remained unknown 24 hours after three masked gunmen removed him from his car as he drove near the Beirut synagogue, in the Jewish quarter of Wadi Abu Jemil.

According to reports from Beirut, Jammous, chairman of the committee representing the 100-member Jewish community, had been under surveillance. Some hours before he was kidnapped, gunmen called at his home seeking

whereabouts. Apparently they waited until he returned and then abducted him. Neither his wife nor Beirut police could offer any explanation for the kidnapping, nor who was responsible. No group, so far, has claimed responsibility.

Last July, another prominent Lebanese Jew, Raul Sobhi Mizrachi, was kidnapped. His body was later found on the seashore south of Beirut. A group calling itself the "National Resistance Arm - The Nation's Liberation Faction" said it killed Mizrachi "because he was an Israeli agent."

## Trial Upcoming For Soviet Jew

NEW YORK (WNS) — Soviet Jewish refusenik Aleksandr Kholmiansky of Moscow, a charismatic 34-year-old Hebrew teacher, has been arrested and is being charged with hooliganism, according to information received here by the Greater New York Conference on

Soviet Jewry. Kholmiansky, who has been waiting for a permission to emigrate since 1978, faces up to a year in prison on the accusation that he trampled on some flowers in a public park. He has been confined since late July, but no trial date has been announced.

JERUSALEM (WNS) — Interior Minister Yosef Burg rejected a proposal by King Hussein of Jordan to convene an international conference on the Middle East. Speaking on Israel Radio, Burg charged that Hussein was actually striving to include Palestinian extremists and the Soviet Union in the peace talks.
