Mrs. Levy was born February 24, 1907 in Kiev, Russia. She was a homemaker and was a member of Temple Beth Shalom, March of Dimes, City of Hope and Daughters of the Nile. She and her husband, Las Vegas residents since 1943, were active in the March of Dimes.

Harry Levy, a prominent Las Vegas businessman, is the civilian chairman of the Civilian Military Council of Southern Nevada. He has been a member of the Las Vegas Housing Authority for more than three decades. The Harry C. Levy Gardens, a 150-unit apartment complex for senior citizens at 2525 W.
