

France's Relations With PLO At All Time Low

PARIS (WNS) — France's relations with the PLO are at an all time low. Palestinian spokesmen are accusing the French government and especially President Francois Mitterrand of "double-talk" in the Middle East.

The usually reliable French paper Le Monde reported from Tunis that Palestinian anger is such that PLO chief Yasir Arafat has refused to meet French Foreign Minister Claude Cheysson. The paper said the two were to confer in Tunis where Cheysson is scheduled

to arrive later this week but Arafat has told the French "he was too busy to meet him." The paper's correspondent in Tunis quoted PLO leaders as warning that the French Socialist Administration is using double-talk in its Mideast dealings, implying that it is telling each side what it wants to hear.

The Palestinians also violently complain that the French are not keeping them informed of their various diplomatic contacts nor about their intentions to launch a diplomatic

Experts Agree: There Is Willingness For Arab-Israeli Peace

WASHINGTON (WNS) — There appears to be a willingness among the Arab countries to consider peace with Israel but there remains no commitment to negotiations to bring it about, according to two Reagan Administration officials and a former Carter Administration Middle East expert.

Howaard Teicher, the Middle East expert on the National Security


Council; Richard Fairbanks, an Ambassador-at-large who formerly dealt with the autonomy talks; and Harold Saunders, Assistant Secretary of State for Near Eastern and South Asian Affairs under President Carter, agreed that the only country the Middle East states look to for help to achieve peace is the United States.

The three experts dis-

cussed "The Future of the Middle East Process; An American Perspective" at the biennial convention of B'nai B'rith International at the Sheraton Washington hotel here. The convention concluded September 6. Teicher told the conference that even as the U.S. is "Villified," country after country comes to the U.S. for assistance because they know the "U.S. will try to help them without screwing up their internal situation."

Jewish Uprising Marked In Bialystok

LONDON (WNS) — The anniversary of the 1943 Jewish uprising against the Nazis which began in the Bialystok ghetto -- the second largest after the Warsaw Ghetto -- was officially commemorated in that Polish City, the World Jewish Congress reported.
