Services for Mischa Violin were held Sunday September 16, in Los Angeles. He died September 3 in Alaska. A Las Vegas resident since 1958, he began playing the violin at the age of 4 when his mother fashioned an instrument out of a cigar box. Born March 15, 1899, in Odessa, Russia, he began formal violin lessons at an early age and later traveled to Germany to study music. He was invited to England by Queen Alexandra for a command performance for the royal family. He then toured South America before settling in the United States. During World War I he did his share by putting about \$1.5 million in the U.S. coffers through special concert tours. Mr. Violin was conductor at the Roxy Theater and the Music Hall in Rockefeller Center in New York City, where he directed the music on the "Music Hall on the Air" radio show for 6-1/2 years. He came to Las Vegas for a vacation with his wife and decided to stay, organizing a series of chamber music concerts, and becoming active in the Las Vegas classical music scene. He is survived by his wife, Jeannette, of Las Vegas; three sons, Roxy and Efrem of Los Angeles and Victor Fisher of Albany, Calif.; sister, Eve Forte of Los Angeles; four grandchildren, and several greatgrandchildren.
