WASH. (WMS) — Succat Shalom is part of a national freeze weekend. Several hundred people gathered across from the White House in Lafayette Park in a demonstration urging the United States, the Soviet Union and all governments of the world to "end the funding, development and deployment of nuclear weapons and begin dismantling the systems that will bring holocaust." The demonstration, called "Succat Shalom, Shelter for Peace," was held in front of a Succah built in the park. Similar programs were held in



Boston, North Hampton, Mass., San Francisco, Chicago, Philadelphia, Seattle, among several other cities; as well as in Toronto and in Israel.
